



CHRISTIAN MINISTRY SCHOLARSHIP REQUIREMENTS

The Christian Ministry Scholarship is for an individual who has spent eight to ten weeks in a full-time Christian ministry, such as a summer camp worker, missionary, or club leader, immediately prior to the semester in which he/she is applying for the scholarship. The recipient of this scholarship is eligible to receive up to \$400 each semester.

Guidelines:

1. To be eligible for this scholarship an applicant must be an accepted or admitted student in a degree-seeking program. And be enrolled as a full-time student (12 + credit hrs. undergraduate / 9 + credit hrs. seminary).
2. The student must have completed a FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid). This will aid us in the awarding process. Please call or see the Financial Aid Office if you need assistance. *The FAFSA must be completed annually.*
3. The applicants Christian ministry leader (pastor, deacon, teacher, etc.) must recommend the applicant by using the Scholarship Recommendation Form and mail it directly to the Financial Aid Office. The reference is not due until after the ministry has been completed or by the start date of the semester for which the applicant is applying for, whichever comes first.
4. Application deadlines are March 1 (early consideration) and April 1 for students entering in the fall semester and by November 15 for *new or transfer* students entering in the spring semester.
5. Decisions on scholarships are made by the Student Aid Committee. The Committee's deliberations and decisions are not public information. A limited number of scholarships will be awarded each year, therefore not all who apply will be awarded. The recipients of the scholarship will be notified by the financial aid office.
6. This scholarship may be applied for annually by the scholarship deadline. Additionally, the student must have a CGPA of at least 2.0 and have nothing that has been "officially" noted that negatively impacts his/her Christian character.
7. In order to make the scholarship program at Calvary a success, all scholarship recipients will be required to perform 5 hours of service at Calvary Bible College, for the spring Alumni Phone-a-thon. This requirement must be met each year that the student receives this scholarship. Students only attending in the fall semester will fulfill their requirements for the Phone-a-thon in the fall.
