



CHRISTIAN WORKERS SCHOLARSHIP for Independent Students

The Christian Workers Scholarship is for independent students involved in full-time Christian work. The Christian worker must be the primary wage earner of the family. The recipient of the scholarship is eligible to receive up to the value of three credit hours a semester (\$400/semester minimum).

Guidelines:

1. To be eligible for this scholarship an applicant must be an accepted or admitted student in a degree-seeking program as a full time student (12+ credit hrs. undergraduate / 9+ credit hrs seminary).
2. The student must have completed a FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid). This will aid us in the awarding process. Please call or see the Financial Aid Office if you need assistance. *The FAFSA must be completed annually.*
3. Application deadlines are March 1 (early consideration) and April 1 for new, transfer and continuing students entering in the fall semester and by November 15 for *new or transfer* students entering in the spring semester.
4. Decisions on scholarships are made by the Student Aid Committee. The Committee's deliberations and decisions are not public information. A limited number of scholarships will be awarded each year, therefore not all who apply will be awarded. The recipients of the scholarship will be notified by the financial aid office.
5. This scholarship must be renewed annually by the scholarship deadline. Additionally, the student must have a CGPA of at least 2.0 and have nothing that has been "officially" noted that negatively impacts his/her Christian character.
6. In order to make the scholarship program at Calvary a success, all scholarship recipients will be required to perform 5 hours of service at Calvary Bible College for the spring Alumni Phon-a-thon. This requirement must be met each year that the student receives this scholarship. Students only attending in the fall semester will fulfill their requirements for the Phon-a-thon in the fall.
