



## MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

Students may only apply for two memorial scholarships a year. This scholarship is for continuing students only. The student must check specific scholarship requirements to be sure of eligibility. Each memorial scholarship will awarded up to \$200 each unless otherwise indicated. Each award is applied to the fall semester only. These scholarships may be reapplied for annually by the scholarship deadlines.\* *Continuing Seminary students may apply only for the Chan scholarship.*

### Guidelines:

1. To be eligible for this scholarship an applicant must be an accepted or admitted student in a degree-seeking program and must carry no less than 12 credit hours (9 hours for seminary). The student must also maintain at least a 2.00 GPA.
2. The student must have completed a FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid). This will aid us in the awarding process. Please call or see the Financial Aid Office if you need assistance. *The FAFSA must be completed annually.*
3. Application deadlines are March 1 (early consideration) and April 1.
4. Decisions on scholarships are made by the Student Aid Committee. The Committee's deliberations and decisions are not public information. A limited number of scholarships will be awarded each year, therefore all who apply will not be awarded. The recipients of the scholarship will be notified by the financial aid office.
5. In order to make the scholarship program at Calvary a success, all scholarship recipients will be required to perform 5 hours of service at Calvary Bible College for the spring Alumni Phon-a-thon. This requirement must be met each year that the student receives a scholarship. Students only attending in the fall semester will fulfill their requirements for the Phon-a-thon in the fall.

**Chan Scholarship:**

Applicants are continuing students who are required to be international students, preferably Chinese or Oriental, pursuing Christian service careers.

\*\*College and Seminary students are eligible – Seminary students must carry at least 9 credit hours and maintain a 3.00 GPA

**Howes Scholarship:**

Applicants are continuing undergraduate students who have demonstrated academic achievement (grade point average over 3.50) and who have financial need, but are doing all they can to meet their college expenses. If you are awarded this scholarship you will be asked to complete further paperwork. Recipient is eligible to receive up to \$1000.

**Izora Crews Scholarship:**

Applicants are continuing undergraduate students who are required to have a burden and a call to the foreign mission field or be children of missionaries on a foreign field, and have a potential for service in a Christian vocation.

**Kreston Scholarship:**

Applicants are continuing undergraduate students who are required to be a full-time student in an education major, who have demonstrated academic achievement.

**Martin Burnham Scholarship:**

Applicants are required to be continuing juniors or seniors and must be pursuing a major in missions. Students must have a call to enter a missions ministry. They must carry a 3.0 CGPA. Recipient is eligible to receive up to \$1000.

**McCarroll Scholarship:**

Applicants are continuing undergraduate students who are required to be preparing for the pastoral ministry, have a burden for and call to the pastoral ministry of an independent, fundamental, Bible-believing church or mission, and have demonstrated an ability to be used by God in the pastoral ministry.

**Morse Church:**

Applicants are required to be *juniors or seniors* employed by the College for the type of work and rate of pay the Business Manager of the College deems them qualified to perform.

**Saiday Abraham Mulbah Scholarship:**

Applicants must be an undergraduate student, either going to Liberia as a missionary, desiring to reach the nationals with the intent of discipling and training them to become church leaders, or they must be majoring in Christian Education, wanting to reach the boys and girls in the public school systems within their community. Recipients must have a servant's heart and a burden to witness to the lost with the gospel of Jesus.

**Robert D. Tuttle and Sheldon Zenger:**

Applicants are continuing *juniors and seniors* who are required to be pursuing a major in pastoral studies, missions, Christian education, or Christian school education and have potential for service in a Christian vocation.

**Toy Tadlock:**

Applicants are continuing undergraduate students who are required to have a burden and call to minister to young people, with a vision to strengthen the home, and have a potential for service in a Christian vocation.

**Women's Auxiliary:**

Applicants are continuing undergraduate students who are required to have financial need, a positive attitude toward the College, and an aptitude for Christian service. The recipient is eligible to receive up to \$250.
